Surf Com rental of club raised by Bob Burns – appraisal has not been done – Stuart Harvey addressed the issue about what is being paid. As previously discussed, want an independent market appraisal of the rental and present it to meeting.

5. Financials - Joe Murray

Auditor John Cheelde addressed the meeting – speaking in general. The accounts are in the same format, incorporated as an association so they need to comply with the rules. Balance sheet, showing assets and liabilities. Profit and Loss statement as per annual report. Explanation of loss from last year – combination of some errors of where funds allocated. Next 12 months should be much clearer and has been simplified. Surf Com is recorded as rental income, with kiosk and café. Go forward and have clearer allocation of funds.

Question – Brett Hunter – forward bookings where deposit held – answer reflected in a holding account and then when function held goes into function account.

Question – Robert Burns – true debtors – have received majority of sponsorship in so debtors is less since April, 2013.

Question – Robert Burns – variations of pricing structures – page 16. We are moving towards package for alcohol at functions not BYO. With our licence we are the supplier and not bringing alcohol to functions.

Question – Howard Jones – BYO brings more bookings – we are working on packages where if they use them we are going to discount the booking fee. Will be discussed at Function meeting and present to the board and will be decided from there.

Question – Howard Jones – bar looks good because wages not paid out of that amount in annual report – needs to be set up to show actual profit.

Garry Clarke advised that going to MYOB in the cloud and going to have a standard charted of accounts will be much clearer where income and expenses will be allocated and clear for members to view.

Question – Robert Burns – funds spent on gym – will new system show members who have paid – Garry Clarke advised new system for the gym and will be much clearer who is a member of the gym.

Question – Robert Dorrell – Clothing expenses – where is the clothing and is any of it going to free – Garry Clarke advised associated with nippers. So balances out. Needs to be clearer where funds in and out. Sonya Walters advised there is stock on the premises. Howard Jones said need print out of every cent in and out. Access will be available for each section to view accounts and know where up to.

The club has contracted Chad and Rebecca who serve the roles of cleaners and caretakers, allowing us to reduce the money we had been spending on previous contract cleaners. While we were unsuccessful with the Gym grant, volunteer labour has seen us progress towards an extension to the facility. Hopefully other members can assist in ensuring the facility is completed and up and running as soon as possible.

We thank Dulux for their continuation of sponsorship of paint and also Mitre 10 for their assistance in this area. They also provided some of the timber for the gym extension.

Garry Clarke worked with Rocky Wolters to secure a grant from Lend Lease to improve the provision of water from our tanks. Hopefully that will be completed in the near future.

FUNCTIONS

Once again the Functions Centre at Avoca Beach Surf Club continued to be busy across most months hosting weddings, corporate meetings and events, as well as private celebrations, Community fundraising events and social groups.

Our venue continues to be a very popular option for weddings, private celebrations and corporate meetings. The revenue stream from the Functions Division, assists with the overall Surf Club financial needs. This year functions have contributed close to \$110,000 to the clubs overall cash flow.

This financial year, the Surf Club has assisted the club members, Avoca residents and Community Groups to host over 100 private events and celebrations for individuals, Community Groups and special events. We've hosted over 80 corporate meetings and 25 weddings.

The primary market for the Functions Centre continues to be weddings across Saturdays and some Fridays. With the success of the Jaws Restaurant small group bookings on Friday nights are no longer as lucrative as they previously were, due to the revenue comparisons the restaurant can provide versus a small booking in the Bar Area.

There has been an increase in the number of corporate meeting bookings in the Club Room. The Function Centre continued to accommodate Community Group events at special hire fee rates. Club functions this year have included activities and feature nights for the Nippers along with our annual events including season Opening Night, Captain's Keg and the Presentation Night.

The Surf Club was an Exhibitor at the largest Wedding Expo on the Central Coast this year to assist in continually building the awareness of the Function Centre as a Wedding Venue. New flyers have been produced to distribute and circulate to the wedding market.

The continued success and growth of the Function Centre bookings allows the Surf Club to provide a great amount of work for our paid staff, members and volunteers. We once again would like to acknowledge the great work of our Function and Events team who work to ensure our events run smoothly, with a high level of service to ensure we maintain our reputation in the market and enable us to continue to develop new bookings and repeat business.

In the coming year, the focus will be to continue to maintain our position as one of the most popular and highly sought-after premium wedding venues on the Central Coast, continued growth in the corporate meetings and events area, as well as the ongoing support of Community Groups and private/special events.

Outside of his surf club interest Neil was also passionate about rugby league. Given the opportunity his beloved South Sydney Rabbitohs were spoken of with great pride and affection. Prior to moving to Avoca Beach Neil was heavily involved in South Eastern JRLFC and South Sydney Junior Rugby League and was honoured with life membership with both sporting organisations. On moving to Avoca Beach Neil continued with this passion joining Erina JRLFC. He brought together his previous and current associations by organising a match between South Eastern JRLFC and Erina JRLFC. Neil was considered very influential and was highly regarded at Erina as he coached a side that was one of the most successful in the division.

Neil was known to Club members and the Avoca Beach community for his honesty, integrity and unforgettable one liners. Whilst it is too difficult to pick only one favourite there is a particular one liner that also epitomises the life Neil led. "Always give your best; you cannot do any better than that". Robbo you certainly did. Farewell Robbo. "A good man".
